All Parents / Guardians must meet the following requirements in regards to conduct during any activity sanctioned by HFI, a member association or an affiliated club event.

- 1. Do not abuse, harass or disrespect and Referee, Match official or ground official.
- 2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- 3. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
- 4. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at your child and other children for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 6. Show appreciation for good performance and skilful plays by all players (including opposing players).
- 7. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age.
- 8. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise
- 9. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, umpire and so on).
- 10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 11. Be a positive role model.

Any Parent or Guardian that does not comply with this Code of Conduct Policy or who otherwise causes a disturbance may be evicted from a venue and is subject to sanction under the HFI disciplinary and grievance regulations, which is available on the HFI website.
